- POSITION:** Environmental Education Intern
- SITE:** MSU's Kellogg Bird Sanctuary. Near Battle Creek, 70 miles from East Lansing
- NUMBER OF POSITIONS AND DURATION:** One (1) Intern at 30 hours/week average for 12 weeks May 15 to August 4, 2017. There will be occasional weekend and evening hours.
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** Intern will gain experience in developing and delivering informal educational programs for all ages. Some examples of responsibilities are:
- Give guided tours to groups of the Bird Adaptations Tour and Agriculture and Ecology Tour
 - Greet and assist visitors regarding their visit to the Bird Sanctuary.
 - Assist callers and visitors with general Sanctuary, Biological Station and wildlife related questions.
 - Develop and deliver educational Wild Wednesday programs for young families
 - Completion of agreed upon intern project focused on educational programming planning. This project will be presented with a poster at the Summer Symposium August 2, 2017.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Current Michigan State University student studying education, wildlife biology, ecology, biology, zoology, animal science, natural sciences or related field.
