POSITION:	<p>The Michigan State University W.K. Kellogg Biological Station (KBS) Pasture Dairy Center is a pasture-based dairy with robotic milking. The dairy facility supports research, education, and outreach activities in the areas of animal health and welfare, dairy production, ecology, pasture management and food systems.</p> <p>The grazing dairy farm management intern will work under the supervision of Howard Straub (Dairy Manager) on farm management (90%) and community outreach (10%) at the KBS Pasture Dairy Center to achieve the research and outreach goals of the Dairy.</p>	
LOCATION:	Michigan State University W.K. Kellogg Biological Station, Hickory Corners, MI. Approximately 65 miles southwest of the main MSU campus in East Lansing.	
POSITIONS DURATION:	<p>The Science Education intern will work approximately 20-24 hours each week at KBS, while taking at least one MSU summer course at KBS.</p> <p>***If you commit to only 1 KBS course over the 11-week internship, and you have no other outside commitments, your internship work load may increase to 30+ hours per week during the session you are not taking a course. There will be occasional weekend and evening hours for events.</p>	
RESPONSIBILITIES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Assist with day-to-day operation of 150 cow pasture-based dairy facility. • Assist researchers with data collection and analysis. • Lead dairy tours and other public outreach events. • Other activities based on student interest and project needs • Participate in designated Professional Development Seminars (T/Th 7: 15-9 p.m.) and the KBS Undergraduate Summer Symposium at KBS 	
QUALIFICATIONS:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic knowledge of farm / livestock management (preferably dairy cattle). • Some lifting required. • Ability to drive a four wheeler and other farm equipment. • Familiarity with Microsoft Excel, Word, Publisher, and PowerPoint. • Ability to work as part of a group and individually with limited supervision. • Good communications and people skills.
