The KBS Conference Center handles all of our room and board accommodations. You should have received a welcome packet from them with information regarding housing rules, meal plan, housekeeping schedule, parking pass, etc. if you are staying on-site at KBS this summer. The front desk will be staffed until 8 pm if you still need a packet.

Normal Front Desk hours are M-F, 9 am - 4:30 pm.

Common areas are the Activity Room (located in the Orchard Dorms) and the McCrary Dining Hall (evenings after dinner). The fire pit in front of the apartments is reserved for student use. You are welcome to bring your own food over to the dining hall during meals even if you are not on the meal plan!

Recreation at KBS (see the Conference Center front desk for more info)

- The soccer field and volleyball courts are located near the lake between the Academic/Stack buildings and the Carriage House.
- Basketball hoops are located in the parking lot behind the Carriage House and Cabins.
- Pool table is located in the Activity Room in the Orchard Dorms.
- Fitness center is out near the farmhouse, on 40th St.
- Canoes are available first-come first served, you just need to fill out a form with the front desk (please be considerate of wedding parties down by the Pagoda/Boat house on weekends).
- KBS has numerous trails onsite, access to the North Country Trail, and Kellogg Forest (<http://agbioresearch.msu.edu/kelloggforest/>).
