- POSITION:** Education Intern
- SITE:** MSU's Kellogg Biological Station and Kellogg Bird Sanctuary. Near Battle Creek/Kalamazoo, 70 miles from East Lansing
- NUMBER OF POSITIONS AND DURATION:** One Intern at 20 hours/week average for 12 weeks May 18 to August 7, 2015.
- KBS is Michigan State University's largest off-campus education complex and one of North America's premier inland field stations. KBS's mission is focused on research and education in ecology and evolutionary biology and its application to sustainable agriculture and conservation. KBS provides professional development for teachers and preservice teachers that focuses on science, the environment and learning/teaching in the outdoor classroom.
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The Education intern's focus will be on assisting in planning, coordinating and participating in teacher workshops, including Teaching Science Outdoors (elementary teachers), Evolution in Action teacher project (preservice teachers) and the K-12 Partnership Summer Institute (middle and high school teachers).
