W.K. Kellogg Bird Sanctuary will host family event celebrating fall waterfowl migration

AUGUSTA, Mich. — The Kellogg Bird Sanctuary will celebrate fall waterfowl migration on Wintergreen Lake with an array of family events on Sunday, November 2, 2014 from 1 to 4 p.m. Events include waterfowl identification tips along the shore of Wintergreen Lake, games and activities along the Sanctuary's trails, and cider and a treat at the end of the walk.

“The Sanctuary was created by W.K. Kellogg to provide a safe haven on Wintergreen Lake for migrating birds,” said Sanctuary's Manager, Lisa Duke. “Visitors can see birds with Northern breeding grounds gearing up for flight to the Deep South.”

Local, award-winning decoy carver Willy McDonald will also be on hand showcasing his work and the process of creating the magnificent decoys.

The event will be free for members and cost general admission for non-members. Non-members purchasing a membership the day of the event will receive a free gift. Members enjoy a full year of Sanctuary admission and membership perks throughout the year.

General Sanctuary admission fees are \$5 for adults, \$4 for seniors (62+) and college students, \$3 for children (two to 17 years old) and free for children younger than two years old.

The Bird Sanctuary is located at 12685 East C Avenue, one mile north of M-89 and just west of 40th Street.

The W.K. Kellogg Bird Sanctuary conserves native habitat for migratory and resident birds and through research, education and outreach helps people gain environmental awareness about our past, present and future.
