Spring Wild Edibles Hike at the W.K. Kellogg Bird Sanctuary

Augusta, Mich. — Have you ever wondered which wild plants are edible? Join the Spring Wild Edibles Hike at the W.K. Kellogg Bird Sanctuary to learn all about wild edible plants.

The hike will be led by the Sanctuary staff, and will begin with a brief educational presentation in the Sanctuary's auditorium. The hike will follow the Lake Loop trail and participants will look for tasty plants as a team and learn about the plants that they encounter.

The hike will take place at the Bird Sanctuary on Saturday, May 21 from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. [Online registration](#) is required by May 14, and is limited to 25 guests, so early registration is encouraged. For Sanctuary members, admission is \$5/adult, \$4/senior or student and \$3/child, and for non-members \$7/adult, \$6/senior or student and \$5/child.
